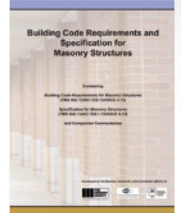

BUILDING CODE CHANGES FOR PA:

WHAT'S NEW FROM 2009 TO 2015 FOR MASONRY (1 AIA/CES LU HSW)

As of October 1, 2018 Pennsylvania updated the building codes from the 2009 to the 2015 version for all of the International Code Council Codes – residential and commercial. The focus of this presentation is the IBC which addresses all commercial structures. This presentation will review changes to concrete masonry unit web requirements, the updated unit strength table, and more that will show greater efficiencies for the masonry walls in many aspects which makes for a more affordable wall with greater energy efficiency.

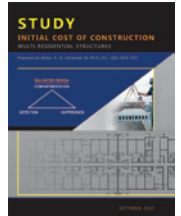

STUDY OF INITIAL COST OF CONSTRUCTION – MULTI-RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURES

(1 AIA/CES LU HSW) By Walter G. M. Schneider III, Ph.D., P.E., CBO, MCP, CFO

The seminar will address typical construction types commonly used in multi-residential construction and their relative performance initially and over time. An explanation will be made of the construction cost model, which accurately evaluates the relative initial construction cost of a multi-family building using different materials. This new study is based on the 2015 IBC using the balanced design approach. You will receive cost information from December 2016, May 2017 and September 2017 for three cities Edgewater, NJ –Towson, MD – Dallas, TX. We will also have cost information for Pittsburgh, Lehigh Valley, Philadelphia, Baltimore and Washington DC as additional local cities studied to date.

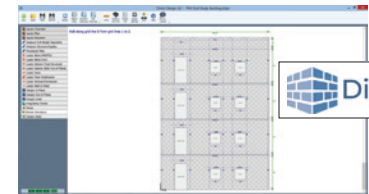

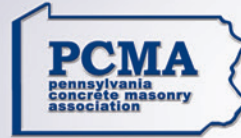
